

# Wallpaper Hanging Instructions



This wallpaper is hand printed. Variations in the print are a natural and accepted part of producing such papers.

This wallpaper is supplied untrimmed and requires trimming during the hanging process. This should be carried out by an experienced professional. We cannot accept responsibility for errors made during the hanging process.

The wallpaper should be hung and double cut on the wall. This allows adjoining edges to be trimmed at the same time and the selvages removed whilst still damp.

## Follow the diagrams below for instructions on how to hang this paper.

To obtain best results, walls should be sound, clean, dry and dust free.

This is a paste the paper product.

We recommend using a wheat based, solvent free, pre-prepared paste.

All purpose, solvent based, powder or flake pastes are **not** suitable for use on this paper.

*Beeline Prepared Tub Paste* is a suitable product.

Our wallpaper has been treated with a protective matt glaze.

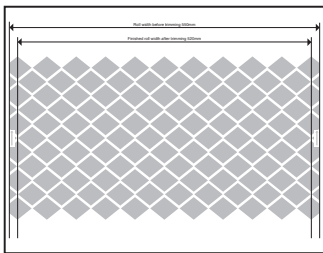
For enhanced protection and to prolong the life of the paper, we recommend the application of a further coat after hanging.

*Polyvine Decorators Varnish* is a suitable product.



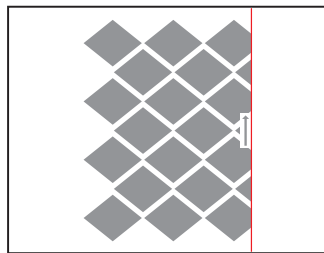

### Step 1



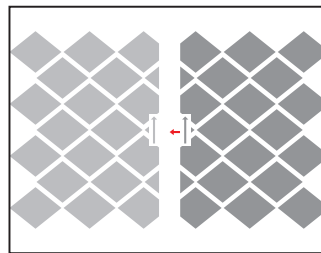
The roll is supplied at 55cm wide. Once installed and trimmed it is 52cm wide.

### Step 2



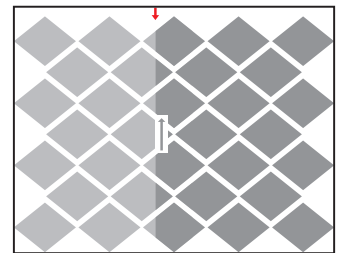
Hang the first piece using a vertical plumb line.

### Step 3



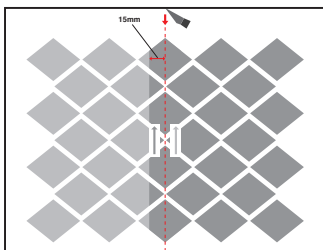
Offer up the second piece ensuring the pattern is aligned horizontally. The orientation arrows will help with this on large scale patterns.

### Step 4



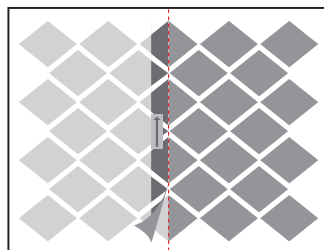
Overlap the second piece until either the pattern matches or by 30mm if the pattern is non-matching, and stick down lightly.

### Step 5



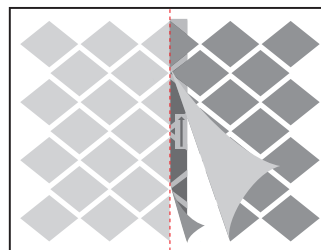
Cut through both pieces with a sharp knife using a straight edge 15mm in from the edge. (Cutting anywhere between the alignment arrows on both pieces will ensure a pattern match).

### Step 6



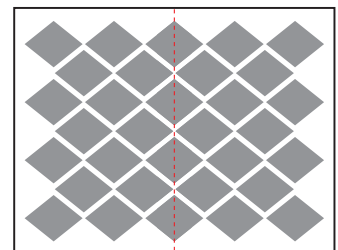
Peel away the excess strip on the second piece.

### Step 7



Fold back the edge of the second piece and peel away the excess strip from the first piece.

### Step 8



Stick the second piece back down. The edges and pattern should match perfectly.
